During Beta testing, it is not uncommon to run into minor issues that FuelCloud will need to fix. Submitting a bug report immediately after an issue occurs allows FuelCloud developers to get the necessary information to understand why an issue occurs and how to fix it.

Reporting a bug in the Beta app is done the same as the current FuelCloud app

#### Submit a Bug Report from the App Menu

1. After the issue occurs, tap the Menu button



#### 2. From the app menu, tap Report a bug



3. If the issue needs an immediate response from FuelCloud, select Option 1. Otherwise, select Option 2.



4. Enter your email, a short description of the issue and tap the plane icon to submit the bug report.
