9. The iPad will then activate with Apple's server. This can take serval minutes.



10. After the iPad has been activated, the iPad will ask to enroll in the FuelCloud MDM. Select

Next in the top right.





11. Enrolling in the FuelCloud MDM can take several minutes.





12. Once the iPad is enrolled in the FuelCloud MDM, select Enable Location Services.

13. The iPad will now launch to the home screen and download the FuelCloud app.





14. The FuelCloud app be greyed out until it has finished downloading and installing. Once done



the app can be used.
